Tuition & Withdrawal Policy

We are so excited to welcome your family to Shorashim! To help us prepare materials, plan engaging programs, and retain wonderful staff for the upcoming school year, we ask that you keep the following tuition schedule and policy in mind:

Important Dates to Remember

- September 1st — Deposit Due: A \$100 deposit per student is due before October 1st to hold your child's spot in our program. (Deposit is applied towards the tuition total and is non-refundable.)
- October 1st — Balance Due: The remaining balance of your annual tuition must be paid in full by October 1st,

Withdrawals & Refund Policy

We understand that unexpected circumstances can arise. If you need to make changes to your child's enrollment, please note the following guidelines:

- Submitting a Request: All withdrawal notifications or refund requests must be submitted in writing directly to the Shorashim administrative office.
- Refund Cutoff: Refund requests submitted in writing on or before November 15th will be honored. After November 15th, all tuition payments are non-refundable.

School Policies

- Toileting:
 - All children who are dropped off must be fully toilet independent.
 - If your child is not fully toilet independent, an adult will need to stay nearby to help them as needed.
- Medical and family considerations
 - Please let us know if your child receives services/para support in school, or has any other support needs, so that we can work together to meet them.
 - We appreciate new or ongoing updates about special family circumstances to help us meet your child's changing needs.
- Photography
 - Photos of the children (included faces) will be shared internally in our newsletter only to participating families and HPCT-CAE administration.
 - Only photos with no faces visible will be posted on our website or on social media, with no identifying personal information attached.
